Appendix E. Effect of behavior-mediated avoidance of cannibals on the stability of the predator-prey system without handling time.

Effect of the strength of the negative behavioral effect of adult predators on the attack rate of juvenile predators, γ , on the stability region of the predator-prey system without handling time (i.e. $T_h = 0$). The handling time does not alter the general effect of γ , but it strongly decreases the stability region of the system in general (compare to figure 3B). All other parameters are equal to Fig. 3B.
